### Save life of Bikash Tiwari, resolve the problem through meaningful dialogue

The serious attention of the National Human Rights Commission has been drawn to the health condition of Bikash Tiwari who has been staging hunger strike for the last 15 days by placing 26 point demands for the overall reformation in the health sector and the management of Raj Biraj based Gajendra Narayan Singh Sagarmatha Zonal hospital of Saptari district.

The Commission has been conducting situation monitoring in this concern. During the monitoring, it has been found that the health condition of Mr. Tiwari has been deteriorating. Whatever may be the form of protest, the Commission would like to draw the attention of the concerned parties to be sensitive towards the health condition of Bikash Tiwari and also to find solution to the problem through meaningful dialogue.

The Commission also urges Nepal Government to pay heed to address the problem of hospital building and equipment in miserable condition, lack of drinking water supply, stinking environment around hospitals due to the unmanaged garbage and ensure the availability of clean drinking water supply, food supply, toilet including the physical facility and quality service in hospitals.
