## High Level Team Comprising Commission's Members Monitored Ganga Maya's Condition

### Commission Dispatched a Letter to Nepal Government Pointing to Quickly Proceed the Act of Saving Her Life Being Sensitive

National Human Rights Commission's serious attention has been drawn towards the fragile health condition of Ganga Maya who was under treatment in the Kathmandu based Bir Hospital for a long time due to repeated hunger strike again started from 29<sup>th</sup> May 2018 demanding to probe the murder of her son Krishna Prasad Adhikari and legal action to the perpetrator. A high level team comprising Commission members Prakash Sharma Wosti and Govinda Sharma Poudyal carried out a monitoring of the health condition of Ganga Maya at Bir Hospital today.

In accordance with the monitoring, her health condition seems to be very delicate, various organs have been swelling and her one leg is paralyzed.

The Commission today urging the government to take action against the guilty person as per the Supreme Court orders, dispatched a letter to the Office of the Prime Minister and Council of Ministers, urging that immediate efforts be taken being sensitive towards her health to save life of Gangamaya Adhikari who has been staging hunger strike. The Commission also dispatched the letter to the Police Headquarter to reply with the progress report in detail what is ensuing to take legal action to the accused.
