Discussion on Various Human Rights Issues Including Development and Environment Protection as well as Consumers' rights with the Stakeholder Agencies by the Commission

National Human Rights Commission, Nepal today held a discussion program with stakeholder agencies on the present condition of physical infrastructure development and its impact on environment and enjoyment of human rights, and role of law enforcement agencies.

Commission member Sudip Pathak drew attention of the Chief District Officers and head of the district police Kathmandu, Bhaktapur and Lalitpur on environmental pollution resulting from physical infrastructure development in Kathmandu valley, food adulteration and growing problems of waste management which has an adverse impact on public health and also on the poor human rights situation in prisons and police custody. He also provided instruction to the officials to submit progress report of the improvement of mentioned issues to NHRCN within 6 months.

The officials expressed their commitment to the NHRCN to controlling environmental pollution and improving human rights situation in the days to come as they are also aware of environmental pollution resulting from physical infrastructure development, consumers' rights and the overall issues of human rights of the valley. In the discussion, director, deputy director and other personnel were also presented.
