Respect the Right to Justice

Save Ganga Maya's Life

National Human Rights Commission draws serious attention towards the severely deteriorating health condition of Ganga Maya Adhikari, who began fast-unto-death for a long time at Bir Hospital for accessing the right to justice which is a basic right. The Commission had drawn the government's attention time and again towards the delayed justice delivery to Ganga Maya.

The Commission has been conducting monitoring health condition of Ganga Maya Adhikari, whose fast-unto-death is continuous. NHRC has received the information of her severely deteriorating health condition due to fast - unto - death for a long time to get justice.

It is unfortunate that the government has not given priority to Ganga Maya's case despite Commission's recommendation to the government and discussion held with the government's responsible authorities to draw attention to translate the Supreme Court verdict into action over the murder of her son Krishna Prasad Adhikari. It has not only cast doubt on the commitments made by the government at the international arena but has curtailed the right to justice ensured by the Constitution. Disregard to the order of judiciary can never be the beauty of any democracy.

The Commission urges the government and the authorities concerned towards the severely deteriorating health condition of Ganga Maya Adhikari to be sensitive and to initiate necessary efforts and actions respecting the individual's right to be ensured the speedy and fair justice guaranteed by the international human rights laws.
