Maintain Peace and Security! Bring the Perpetrator into Legal Action!

National Human Rights Commission, Nepal draws its attention seriously towards the incident of murder after abducting the child Prayash Kuwar in the evening on 26 November, 2018 from Gongabu, Kathmandu.

Hon. Member of the Commission, Govinda Sharma Poudyal led high level team monitored the incident. The team received information from family relations and local persons involved in community service. While monitoring, the team also received the related information of the incident from the Forensic Department of TU Teaching hospital, Maharajjung.

To abduct and murder a child from the sensitive place like national capital raises a serious question to the peace and security and has created fear and intimidation to the whole citizens. The increased abduction, murder like criminal incidents in the recent time shows the violation of an individual's right to live with liberty.

The Commission draws attention of all concerned parties towards such incidents which has serious psychological impact upon the children. The Commission requests to all concerned parties cause not to recur such incidents as well as to be sensitive to the security of the children. Similarly, the Commission request to the government of Nepal to probe the incident fairly and take appropriate legal action to the perpetrator as soon as possible and provide reparation to the victims' family.
