Save Dr. K.C.'s life, resolve the problem through talk

The National Human Rights Commission has monitored the health condition of Dr. Govinda K.C. who has been staging hunger strike since September 26, 2016 demanding the end of irregularities in Tribhuvan University (Teaching Hospital) and the new Medical Education Act. Following the monitoring, the serious attention of the Commission has been drawn to the health condition of Dr. K.C.

The monitoring team deployed by the Commission has received the information about the health condition of Dr. K.C. from the doctors involved in his treatment. It has been learnt that Dr. K.C.'s health condition is deteriorating due to the fluctuation in the amount of blood flow in his body, breathing problem and joint pain, as per the monitoring.

Since person's treatment is related to right to live whatsoever be the way of protest, the Commission would like to draw the attention of all the concerned parties to be sensitive immediately towards saving his life. The Commission also urges Dr. K.C. and Nepal Government to seek the solution to the problem through dialogue.

Similarly, the Commission also urges Nepal Government to timely pay heed to the health condition of civil society fore-runner Chitanya Prakash Mainali who has been staging fast-unto death expressing his solidarity for six-point demand placed by civil society including the approval of a medical college to Birta mode based B&B Hospital, Jhapa district.
