Ensure people's Right to Information

The National Human Rights Commission is seriously concerned over the incident of vandalism caused this morning to Dhading based community 'Radio Dhading 106 Mhz, Women Safe House by District Forest Office and Security Force.

A complaint has been lodged at the Commissions in connection with the vandalism caused to women safe house which houses six helpless women including a four old baby and Dhading Radio. The Commission has deployed an investigation team to the incident site to conduct investigation into the incident.

The Commission, therefore, urges Nepal Government to make the arrangement of unhindered radio broadcasting of the community radio vandalized during the incident to shift the women and the baby sheltered in the safe house to a safe place with immediate effect. The Commission also urges to probe into the incident to bring forth the factual truth and advance necessary action.
