Special Discussion on the Incident of Raj Pariyar's Injury due to Police's Physical Assault: Commission directs the Government to Accomplish Free Treatment of the Injured Person.

National Human Rights Commission draws its serious attention to the brutal physical assault on Raj Pariyar by the police deployed from the Metropolitan Police Circle Sorakhutte on 23rd January, 2018 arresting him from his rented room into a disputed case with Niru Nepali, both of whom were living at Kathmandu Metropolitan City – 17 in rented rooms in the same house. The Commission has also initiated probe into the incident.

Due to physical assault taking in control by the Police, Pariyar suffered spinal cord injury with no movement of the organs below the loins and is receiving treatment in National Trauma Centre. Commission received the information through the initial investigation that his economic status is very low. In this issue, Commission after its sudden meeting in accordance with the National Human Rights Commission Act 2068 section 9 (5) and 11 (2) directed the Nepal Government to provide free treatment to Pariyar and to inform the Commission.
