Commission's Suggestion on the Report that Will Be Submitted on UNCAT Committee by the Nepal Government

National Human Rights Commission, Nepal has sent its opinion/suggestions in accordance with the section 6 of NHRC Act -2012 to the Government of Nepal on the third, fourth, fifth, sixth and seventh integrated report to UN CAT Committee which is going to be submitted on behalf of Nepal government.

The suggestions in the past are still not materialized so the suggestions mentioned to improve the situation regularly and include to manage the detention centers as there are more detainees than the capacity, to reconstruct the new ones as there are very old detention centers and to renovate the old buildings, to transfer into the safe places after assessing the vulnerability of the lives of the detainees due to earthquake. The opinion/suggestions of the Commission have been submitted to manage the drainage of the detention centers for hygienic environment and sanitation, to increase the daily allowance provided to the detainees and the dependent children timely as it is very low, to manage the daily health checkup as the problem is seen on health, to provide free legal aid with access to justice to the detainees in trial hearing, to establish the child reform homes in the remote areas, and to mention the issue of being active to coordinate in the implementation of the suggestions to the Government by the Commission for improving the draft bill on torture compensation.
