Discussion with the Experts Regarding the Investigation of Nirmala Pant of Kanchanpur District Case

National Human Rights Commission, Nepal conducted a discussion program today with the medico-legal and DNA experts regarding the rape and murder Nirmala Pant of Kanchanpur district aiming to collect the suggestions on medico examination and scientific examination of physical evidences. In the discussion, copies of reports of DNA and Autopsy (post-mortem) were minutely studied.

After this discussion, NHRCN has directed Nepal Police headquarters to keep safe and intact the sample of Nirmala Panta's vaginal swab collected by Central Police Forensic Science Laboratory and the isolated DNA from that sample, along with other physical evidences.

The NHRCN has also written to Mahakali Zonal Hospital, Kanchanpur, directing it to provide with information about the procedures adopted while collecting Nirmala's vaginal swab and sending it to Central Police Forensic Science Laboratory.

NHRC Acting Chairperson Prakash Osti, NHRC member Sudip Pathak, forensic expert of Forensic Medicine Department at Tribhuvan University Teaching Hospital Dr Harihar Osti and DNA expert of National Forensic Science Laboratory Dr Dinesh Jha, Officiating Secretary of NHRCN Murari Prasad Kharel, Deputy Director Lok Nath Bastola were among those present during the discussion.
