### **NHRC Urges Guarantee of Peace with Security Beef Up**

The serious attention of the National Human Rights Commission has been drawn to the incident of bomb explosion at Ramananda Chok, Janakpur at around 10 am in the Monday morning in which four people lost their lives and 28 others reported to have sustained injury.

The NHRC condemns the incident targeted to the sit-in program organized by the Mithila State Action Committee including the civil society, intellectuals, journalists, and professors of Janakpur.

The NHRC, therefore, urges the Government to launch the fair investigation over the incident in order to identify the perpetrators and drag them to justice. The NHRC also appeals to the government for the provision of effective treatment to the injured.

At a time when the new constitution is about to come into effect, the occurrence of such an incident is unfortunate and saddening. The NHRC, therefore, appeals to the Government to beef up security so as to ensure the peace and security of the citizens.
