## Press Note

January 21, 2016

The National Human Rights Commission has been regularly monitoring the ongoing agitation sparked in Tarai Madhesh over the issue related to the constitution including the impact left on human rights situation due to the agitation. By publicizing its opinion with regard to the de-facto human rights situation on the basis of monitoring, therefore, the Commission has drawn the attention of all the concerned parties by making necessary recommendations.

As per the preliminary report publicized by the Commission, 49 people including common citizens, children and security personnel have been killed during the agitation. In order to conduct investigation into the incidents reported in the report, therefore, the Commission has deployed 5 monitoring teams comprising the Deputy Directors and Human Rights Officers in Bara, Parsa, Morang, Sunsari, Rupandehi, Mahottari and Saptari among other districts as per the decision drawn on 4th January, 2015.

The Commission urges the families of the victims, political parties and all the concerned authorities of the Government of Nepal for necessary cooperation to the monitoring teams deployed by the Commission.
