Stakeholders discuss on the National Human Rights Action Plan

A discussion program was held at the Commission between the National Human Rights Commission and various stakeholder agencies with regard to the development of monitoring mechanism for the implementation of National Human Rights Action Pan (NHRAP).

At the program, the Chief Secretary of Government of Nepal Somlal Subedi said that the government is all set to formulate the implementation plan to implement it soon.

Citing the complaints regarding the Government mechanisms being oblivion to be obligatory towards the general people, Chief Secretary Subedi urged the government staff to pay heed to towards this. 'Despite the fact that all the parties have expressed their collective commitment to make the schools as zone of peace in their party manifestoes, the implementation of this is in dismal state and thus due sincerity towards one's duty is the need of the hour,' the Chief Secretary Subedi observed.

On the occasion, the Chairperson Justice Anup Raj Sharma said that though the NHRAP encompasses the matters of vital concern, the government does not appear to be serious towards the implementation of the plan. 'The implementation of the plan couldn't tap momentum due to the chiefs of district level government agencies being unaware about the plan,' the Chairperson Sharma claimed.

At the program, Joint Secretary of Office of the Prime Minister and Council of Ministers Ramesh Dhakal and Human Rights Officer Badri Subedi presented the working paper separately on the implementation status of the NHRAP.

Similarly, Commissioners Prakash Osti, Mohna Ansari and Govinda Sharma Poudyal said the Commission is doing homework in developing the separate mechanism to make monitoring on NHRAP further effective.

Chaired by the Chairperson Justice Anup Raj Sharma, the program was attended by the representatives of various government agencies, human rights workers, professional organizations, and the front runners of civil society.
