## Request for instant and effective effort to Save Ganga Maya's Life

National Human Rights Commission, Nepal draws its serious attention towards the health condition of Ganga Maya Adhikari, who has been staging fast-unto-death at Bir Hospital for accessing the right to justice one of the basic rights. The Commission team led by Hon member Sudip Pathak and comprising officers has again monitored her health condition today.

The Commission has been conducting continuous monitoring of her health condition who is staging fast-unto-death demanding investigation and legal action to the perpetrator over the murder of her son Krishna Prasad Adhikari. The health condition of Ganga Maya is being critical and deteriorating day by day because of continuous fast- unto- death for a long time. NHRC has also received the information of people being prevented to meet her showing the reason that patient can be affected by infection according to hospital administration. The Commission has recommended to the government of Nepal on 5<sup>th</sup> April, 2009 to prosecute the perpetrator after investigation and to provide compensation to the victim.

No denial of right to get speedy and fair justice is ensured by the international and national human rights laws, so, with keeping faith on speedy justice can only respect and protect human rights. The Commission has time and again drew attention to the Nepal government to save Ganga Maya making an effective effort to prevent the extra deterioration of Ganga Maya's health but was ignored, so, the Commission once again draws attention of the concerned all to make instant effort to save her life as well as to provide her speedy justice.
