Be Sensitive to Protect the Life of Ganga Maya Adhikari

The health condition of Ganga Maya Adhikari is being critical and deteriorating who has been staging fast-unto-death for 30 days demanding to implement the verdict to put on remand the accused Chabilal Poudel for trial by the Supreme Court of Nepal. Her son Krishna Prasad Adhikari was murdered by the then Maoist cadres during the conflict era.

The Commission has been conducting monitoring to protect her life. With the effort of the Commission, Ganga Maya Adhikari has accepted and admitted to ICU of Bir Hospital for her treatment on 27th June, 2018.

She will not quit the fast – unto – death if the issues raised have not heard, as she pronounced, so NHRC called discussion meeting with Home Secretary of Nepal Government Prem Kumar Rai and Inspector General of Nepal Police, Sarbendra Khanal with the aim to draw attention of the Nepal government for addressing her demand and to save human rights that are tied up with the rule of law and the situation of impunity.

During the meeting, NHRC Chairman Anup Raj Sharma, Members Sudip Pathak, Mohna Ansari and Govinda Sharma Poudyal were participated and the Commission urged the high level government officials and IGP to implement the Supreme Court verdict and bring to book the culprits by bringing the fugitive in country by issuing red corner notice or any diplomatic channel.

Home Secretary and IGP Khanal expressed that the government is committed to implement the Supreme Court's verdict and bring to book the culprits by bringing the fugitive in country by issuing red corner notice and maintaining rule of law that would take immediate measure to end the impunity.
