Request to Ensure Respect for Human Dignity

National Human Rights Commission draws serious attention towards the incident of regulating two hours' time of vice – chancellor of Nepal Sanskrit University Pro. Dr. Kula Prasad Koirala in the Prime minister's residence, Baluwatar taking him into control by the Nepal Police from Tribhuvan International Airport on 7th July 2018, during his visit to an International Sanskrit Conference at Canada as a special guest.

NHRC has received its complaint. The Commission has taken the incident seriously. The act of taking into control to one academic personnel and the vice chancellor of the University without considering dignity and respect by responsible agency is against the value and norms of human rights.

So, the Commission urges the all concerned parties to be sensitive towards this because the act like this ensued over the academic personnel like vice chancellor of a University, an autonomous body, violates individual's social dignity and respect.
