National Inquiry Training concluded on Human Rights Violation

A three day training on National Inquiry was organized jointly by the National Human Rights Commission and the Asia Pacific Forum of National Human Rights Institutions (APF) effecting from 29 - 31 August, 2016.

Speaking at the inaugural session of the training, Chairperson Justice Anup Raj Sharma opined that the participants of the training will gain both theoretical and practical knowledge which they can significantly contribute for the protection and promotion of human rights in practical term. He added that the Commission is all set to organize public hearing on the subjects of human rights concerns.

Speaking on the occasion, NHRC Secretary Bed Prasad Bhattarai said that the objective of the training is to address the incidents of serious human rights violation in coordination and collaboration with the stakeholders and improve overall human rights situation of the country. He claimed that there is a provision that the Commission can form the Committee to explore the truth about the incidents, to collectively address the causes and remedial solutions to the incidents of rights violations. He also expressed his hope that the training would be effective to fulfill the objective of the National Inquiry on human rights violations, 2073 issued this past month.

Mr. Chris Siddoti, former Member of National Human Rights Commission of Australia and an expert, facilitated the three day long training. He underscored that child rights and the women's rights concerns are the main objectives of the APF though, it is focused on streamlining the significant process of updating the community or the stakeholders about the investigation into the truth related to the subjects of human rights violation via National Inquiry together with the overall human rights.

At the closing of the training, NHRC Commissioner Mohna Ansari remarked that the National Inquiry will be a medium that facilitates a support to unearth the complex systematic problems of human rights of the country sitting at one point in a transparent manner, to avail access to justice for the victim and to make the state accountability further effective.
