NHRC urges to book the accused

The attention of the Commission has been drawn to the incident of arson in which a bus bearing the number *Ba 2 Kha 5672* was torched in Kavre district during the Bandh called by the CPN- Maoists.

Although, all deserve the right to protest peacefully for having their demands meted out in a democratic system, violent incidents such as arson and vandalism cause the deprivation of the right to live in an environment free from fear. The Commission, therefore, urges the Government to identify the accused and take action against those involved in the act that causes the loss of property and lives thereby harboring panic and terror among the general citizens.

Likewise, the Commission also urges all the concerned stakeholders to reach to the conclusion through dialogue and consensus about the issues of discontentment.
