### Commission urges to relocate 13 VDCs of Gorkha district

The a team of local residents and stakeholders of the earthquake ravaged Gorkha district have met with the NHRC officials and requested to take initiatives for relocating 13 earthquake affected Village Development Committees under serious risk at a safe place. They also urged to ensure the religious and cultural rights of the people while making an effort to shift the human settlement.

At the discussion, they have requested to open the road to and from Tibet pass saying that the movement via this pass was convenient for easy transportation of the foods, to make appropriate arrangement of foods, to overcome the food shortage, to relocate the earthquake affected villages at safe place, to search the victims buried under landslides, to distribute the indentify card to the genuine earthquake survivors, and also to make the appropriate arrangement of relief distribution of compensation in smooth and uncomplicated manner.

Chairperson Justice Anup Raj Sharma has said that the Commission would take necessary initiatives for relocating 13 VDCs of Gorkha, which are under serious risk after the devastating earthquake.

### Concern expressed on the murder of Krishna Prasad Adhikari

The Commission has expressed concern on the investigation taking place about the murder of Krishna Prasad Adhikari of Fujel VDC, Gorkha in the context of the 11<sup>th</sup> year of Adhikari's murder.

Meanwhile, Commissioners Sudit Pathak and Mohna Ansari visited Gangamaya Adhikari undergoing treatment at Trauma Center. She expressed her ignorance about ongoing efforts with regard to postponement of hearing date of Adhikari's murder case, red corner notice issued by the Interpol.
