NHRC Urges to Keep the Door open for Dialogue and Consensus

KAHMANDU: The NHRC team comprising the Acting Secretary Bed Prasad Bhattarai met with the Secretary of CPN-Maoist Dev Gurung at the CPN Maoist central office, Buddha Nagar and urged the latter to call off the activities including Bandh that would have the severe impact on the lives of general citizens.

The NHRC team urged the CPN Maoists to find out the solution to the problems through dialogue and consensus in order to evade the emergence of confrontation leading to further conflict after the CA election.

Stating that it is the democratic right whether to participate or to boycott the election, Secretary Gurung said that the all the protest programs are of peaceful nature and expressed his commitment to respect human rights

Meanwhile, the NHRC team reminded about the attention of the Government of Nepal, political parties and all concerned stakeholders parties drawn to have high respect towards human rights
