NHRC to establish Offices in all 75 Districts

The National Human Rights Commission has made the preparation including the concept paper for setting up its offices under its purview in all seventy five districts. The main objective of the expansion of its offices is to raise awareness of human rights among the local level citizens, to protect and promote human rights of people and to increase the public access to the Commission with regard to the issues concerning human rights violations and abuses.

The Commission today dispatched a letter including the concept paper to the Prime Minister and the Office of the Council of Ministers notifying about its endeavor to gradually set up the contact offices in all seventy five districts.

In this regard, the Commission had had reached the policy-wise decision on March 11, 2013 with regard to setting up its offices throughout the country.

At present, the Commission has its Central Office, Regional Offices and Sub-Regional Offices in nine different districts. The Regional Offices are in Biratnagar, Janakpur, Nepalgunj and Dhangadhi respectively whereas the Sub-Regional Offices are in Butwal, Jumala and Khotang.

Establishing its offices in all the districts across the country, the Commission believes that it can pledge support to address the spirit of the National Human Rights Action Plane (NHRAP) introduced by the Government and the local level issues of human rights violations and abuses with prompt effect.
