NHRC Urges the Immediate Rescue of the Natural Disaster Affected Victims

The attention of the Commission has been drawn to the loss of lives and properties and the situation emerged from it due to torrential rainfall in various parts of the country.

It is learned that around 10 people have lost their lives, hundreds of pilgrims have been stranded on their way to Kailash Mansarovar, the roads have been damaged and the houses along with cowsheds have been swept away due to the monsoon rainfall. Following this, the normal life of the people has been hit hard in the districts including Darchula, Kanchanpur, Dadledhura, Humla, Kalikot, Achcham, Baitadi, Nawalparasi and Rupandehi.

The Commission, therefore, urges the Government to ensure to make appropriate arrangement for the rescue, relief and rehabilitation of the victims affected from flood and landslide in parts of the country. Similarly, the Commission also urges the Government to mobilize maximum number of human recourses for the necessary search missions for those disappeared in the deluge.
