NHRC urges to end the Bandh Culture

The Commission has been urging the bandh enforcers time and again to respect people's fundamental rights such as right to freedom of movement, right to education, right to health and free movement of the very much essential public services.

The Commission urges the bandh enforcers not to take any move that would invite problem to the people but sort out the problem through dialogue and consensus.

The Commission also urges the Government to address in time the legitimate demands of the bandh enforcers and maintain peace and security in the country.
