NHRC expresses Concern over Media Report

The serious attention of the National Human Rights Commission has been drawn to the media report entitled 'Bandha program is prohibited while in Peace Process' published in the Annapurna daily dated April 6, 2015. The Commission condemns the news. The Commission has not issued any formal decision over the program of general strike called by the Thirty Party Alliance including the UCPN (Maoists).

The Commission would like to hereby clarify that the published piece of news, if true, is the absolute personal opinion of Commissioner Sudip Pathak.
