NHRC Urges for smooth supply petroleum product including LP Gas

The serious attention of the National Human Rights Commission has been drawn to the sudden crisis of the petroleum products including LP gas in the market.

Reminding the inclusion of the transportation and supply of petroleum products including LP gas, storage including selling and distribution listed under very essential service in the Monitoring Guidelines on the Protection and Promotion of Consumers Rights – 2012, the Commission would like to draw the attention of all concerned stakeholder authorities to take effective steps for the regular and adequate supply of such essential commodities.

It is clear that such a crisis of petroleum product has left impact on the people's daily life including their right to free movement. The Commission, therefore, would like to draw the attention of the Government of Nepal (GoN) to regularly conduct monitoring on unethical practice such as artificial shortage created by the sellers and distributors and drag them to legal justice in order to make the arrangement for easy supply of the very essential commodities.
