Protest Program of Thirty Party Alliance

Discussion held with the Chiefs of the Security Agencies and Representatives of the Thirty Party Alliance

KATHMANDU: The National Human Rights Commission held discussion separately with the chiefs of the security agencies of the valley and the representatives of the thirty party alliance on the human rights concerns prior to the protest program scheduled for Saturday.

At the discussion held separately at the Commission, Chairperson Justice Anup Raj Sharma drew the attention of the concerned stakeholders to ensure the rights of citizens to organize peaceful protest programs and to maintain peace and security.

The NHRC monitoring team will be mobilized for situation monitoring during the protest program.

At the discussion, Chief District Officers and the Chiefs of the Security Agencies said that they are doing their utmost to step up the security situation in the wake of the announcement of the protest program of the Thirty Party Alliance.

Similarly, at the discussion, the representatives of the thirty party alliance said that they are committed to protecting the rights of the citizens and would do their best for the peaceful protest and restrain.

At the program held separately, discussions were held on the fulfillment of human rights during the protest program, management of the protest program, right to freedom of movement, protection of the rights of the demonstrators, security personnel including the general citizens.

Representing the thirty party alliance, Barsaman Pun, Hridayesh Tripathi, Jhakku Prasad Subedi, Salikram Jamarkattel and Pasang Sherpa were present in the discussion program.

Representing the Security Agencies, Additional Inspector General of Police Bigyan Raj Sharma, the Metropolitan Police Office, Additional Inspector General of the Armed Police Force Jiwan Thapa, Chief of Metropolitan Police Range, Uttam Kumar Karki, Senior Superintendent of Police, Lalitpur District Police Office Pushpa Chandra Ranjit and District Superintendent of Police of Bhaktapur District Police Office Bikash Shrestha were present at the discussion program.
