NHRC Urges Unhindered Drinking Water Supply

The attention of the National Human Rights Commission has been drawn to the situation emerged from the hindrance caused to the supply of drinking water supply by the water supply companies with various demands placed forth.

Such a move to make very essential drinking water supply scarce in market as the matter of bargain is sheer inhumane and downright against human rights.

Drinking water supply is associated with the citizens' fundamental human rights and it wouldn't do any better if undue hindrance is caused to the water supply.

The Commission, therefore, urges the Government of Nepal to give continuity to the smooth and easy supply of drinking water keeping in mind the fundamental rights of the consumers.
